**Approach:** Describe how the research will be carried out. What method will be used to obtain, measure, and analyze the data? What safeguards will be used to ensure that the data are viewed as credible by the scientific community?

**Investigator Qualifications:** Describe your qualifications for completing the proposed research. Do you have any previous research or professional experience with the proposed topic or approach? How has your training or background prepared you for conducting this particular study?

**Environment:** Describe the resources, facilities, and support available to you. Your responsibility in this section is to assure reviewers that successful completion of your proposed research is a realistic expectation.
